For LLM Students:

AR 4013. Grading scale. Students shall be graded according to the following system: (E) for excellent or outstanding performance; (VG) for very good or very creditable performance; (G) for good or average performance; (P) for passing or acceptable performance; and (NP) for not passing or unacceptable performance. **With the permission of the Dean of Students, an LL.M. student may be graded according to the grading scale set forth in §903. An LL.M. student must elect grading according to §903 by the end of the add/drop period of their first semester of enrollment, and such election shall determine grading for all courses subject to §903 taken at the College.****

AR 903. Grade point equivalents. Points are assigned for grades on the following basis for purposes of computing the grade point average: A+ = 4.3 grade points per unit; A = 4.0; A- = 3.7; B+ = 3.3; B = 3.0; B- = 2.7; C+ = 2.3; C = 2.0; C- = 1.5; D = 1.0; F = 0.

For Foreign Exchange Students:

I request to elect letter grading per *Academic Regulation 7005*. I understand this election will apply to all classes in which I am enrolled at UC Law San Francisco.

AR 7005. Grades. Foreign exchange students are graded according to the following scale: (E) for excellent or outstanding performance;(VG) for very good or very creditable performance; (G) for good or average performance; (P) for passing or acceptable performance; and (NP) for not passing or unacceptable performance. **With the permission of the Dean of Students, a foreign exchange student may be graded according to the grading scale set forth in §903. A foreign exchange student must elect grading according to §903 by the end of the add/drop period of their first semester of enrollment, and such election shall determine grading for all courses subject to §903 taken at the College.****

AR 903. Grade point equivalents. Points are assigned for grades on the following basis for purposes of computing the grade point average: A+ = 4.3 grade points per unit; A = 4.0; A- = 3.7; B+ = 3.3; B = 3.0; B- = 2.7; C+ = 2.3; C = 2.0; C- = 1.5; D = 1.0; F = 0.
