Pride Month Legal Issues and Cases of Interest: UC Law SF Constitutional Law Experts Available to Discuss

UC Law SF can provide experts for media coverage of LGBTQ+ rights. Current and recent cases include:

- The United States Supreme Court today agreed to take up a case on a Tennessee law that bans gender-affirming care for transgender youths.
- Justice Sotomayor’s dissent in Department of State vs. Munoz – a case dealing with immigration and international marriage – notes that “Same-sex couples may be forced to relocate to countries that do not recognize same-sex marriage, or even those that criminalize homosexuality.”

Professor Matt Coles, former Deputy National Legal Director at the ACLU, is a professor of practice and constitutional law expert at UC Law SF. At the ACLU, he was responsible for the organization’s work on race, voting, disability and immigration. Prior to that, he ran the ACLU’s LGBT project for 15 years.
